Encouraging Youth to Keep Our Planet Green

This contest encourages students to keep our planet green and to get involved with saving the environment. Students in grades 4 through 8 are eligible to create a sculpture of recyclable, reused, and reduced materials. The sculpture is limited in width to 8-1/2 inches by 11 inches. Height should be proportional to width.

Contest Rules

- Children in 4th through 8th grade will be eligible to enter the contest
- Sculptures must consist of recyclable, reused and reduced materials
- Width of the sculpture can be no more than 8 1/2 x 11 inches
- Height should be in proportion to width
- Entries should include as many photographs as can be printed on the back of the entry form but two 4x6 photographs are recommended
- Local Club 1st place entries for each grade, Publication Release Forms and the Local Club Youth Contests Submission Form must be **received by** MGC Youth Contests Co-Chair, Kathleen Sauber, by **January 15, 2021**.

- Creative use of materials and self-expression: 60%
- Description of sculpture and materials used: 30%
- Craftsmanship and technique: 10%
