If a flower show receives the 'go ahead' to prepare a Book of Evidence (it must score 95 or above), follow the rules and directions for applying for a NGC Flower Show Achievement Award. Send the completed Book of Evidence to the MGC Advice and Awards Chair by October 1. Each application for an NGC Flower Show Achievement Award will be considered for one of the MGC Flower Show Awards as described and listed here.

Michigan Gold (NGC Club Standard Flower Show)

A Standard Flower Show given by one MGC club.

One may be awarded to each of four clubs based on membership.

- a. **FS-1A**, (clubs with fewer than 21 members) One educational exhibit required; more okay)
- b. **FS-1B**, (clubs with 1-49 members) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.
- c. **FS-1C**, (clubs with 50-99 members) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.
- d. **FS-1D**, (clubs with 100+ members) Two Education exhibits and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Lavender Lace (NGC Near Club Standard Flower Show)

A Standard Flower Show given by two or more MGC clubs. (2+ clubs nearby)

FS-9, One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Buttercup Award (NGC Club Small Standard)

A Small Standard Flower Show given by one garden club.

- a. **FS-5A**, Small Size Club (fewer than 21 members) FS-5A One or more Education exhibits required.
- FS-5B, Medium Size Club (21-49 members) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.
- FS-5C, Large Size Club (50-99 members) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits) required.

Daffodil Award (NGC Petite Standard Flower Show)

A Petite Standard or Small standard Flower Show in which all horticulture and design exhibits qualify as Petite Divisions.

FS-4A (one member club) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

FS-4B (two or more member clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Holly and Ivy (NGC Holiday Standard Flower Show)

Show must feature the spirit of the holidays using a minimum of artificial decorative materials and NO artificial flowers or foliage.

FS-2A Holiday Standard, (one member club) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

FS-2B, Holiday Standard (two or more member clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Snowflake (NGC Holiday Small Standard Flower Show)

Show must feature the spirit of the holidays using a minimum of artificial decorative materials and NO artificial flowers or foliage.

FS-6 Holiday <u>Small</u> Standard, (one member club with less than 100 members) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

Red, White and Blue (NGC Patriotic Standard Flower Show)

Show must have a patriotic theme. The flag of the United States of America must be correctly and prominently displayed. Exhibitors shall not be limited to the use of so-called patriotic colors (red, white and blue) in the entries. All colors and values shall be permitted. The show must feature the spirit of patriotic traditions, using a minimum of artificial decorative materials and NO artificial flowers or foliage.

FS-3A (one member club) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

FS-3B (two or more member clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Red, White and Blue (NGC Patriotic Small Standard Flower Show)

Show must have a patriotic theme. The flag of the United States of America must be correctly and prominently displayed. Exhibitors shall not be limited to the use of so-called patriotic colors (red, white and blue) in the entries. All colors and values shall be permitted. The show must feature the spirit of patriotic traditions, using a minimum of artificial decorative materials and NO artificial flowers or foliage.

FS-7 (one member club with fewer than 100 members) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

Michigan Platinum (NGC District Flower Show)

A MGC District Standard Flower Show

FS-11A, (district containing 15 or fewer member clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

FS-11B (district having 16 or more member clubs) Two Education exhibits and at least two additional Education. Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Michigan Diamond (NGC State Standard Flower Show)

FS-12A, (small state; fewer than 100 member clubs with 10% of adult clubs participating) Two (2) educational exhibits, and at least any combination of three (3) additional education exhibits, Botanical Arts Division Sections, or Youth/Sponsored Groups sections.

FS-12-B, (large state; 100 or more member clubs with 10% of adult clubs participating) *Horticulture Division: minimum of 20 classes with at least 80 exhibits total *Design Division: minimum of 20 classes with at least 4 exhibits in each class. Five (5) educational exhibits, and at least any combination of five (5) additional education exhibits, Botanical Arts Division Sections, or Youth/Sponsored Groups Section

Michigan Garnet (NGC Council Standard Flower Show)

FS-10A (sponsored by at least 3 member clubs belonging to an association, federation, group, circle, etc. and recognized by the State Garden Club) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

FS-10B (Judges Council/s Standard Flower Show) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Michigan Emerald (NGC Horticulture Specialty Show)

FS-15A (one club) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

FS-15B (two or more clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

FS-15C (council, district, state or region sponsoring organization) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

Michigan Topaz (NGC Design Specialty Show)

FS-16A (one club) One Education exhibit and at least one additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibit required.

FS-16B (two or more clubs) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.

FS-16C (council, district, state or region sponsoring organization) One Education exhibit and at least two additional Education, Botanical Arts or Youth/Sponsored Group exhibits required.
