Optional Exam

For Consultants Certification

All Michigan Garden Clubs (MGC) members who successfully complete all four courses with exam results at 70% or higher will qualify for title of National Garden Clubs (NGC) "Gardening Consultant."

The exam will be conducted by remote computer submission. The exam will be emailed to participants on September 15th, and completed submission is due no later than midnight on September 22, 2025.

There will be 40 questions on material covered in classroom. This optional exam may be completed with open book/notes and submitted online.

Nonmembers may complete the courses and the exam, join an MGC garden club within a year from the last course, and become an NGC "Gardening Consultant."

All MGC Gardening Consultants also automatically become a member of the MGC Michigan Consultants Council at no cost.

There is also an option of continuing education to renew an NGC "Gardening Consultant" title every five years.

All attendees seeking credit for this program must have an NGC Form 6 or 7 on record with the MGC School State Chair.
