EXAM

For Consultants Certification

All Michigan Garden Clubs (MGC) members who successfully complete all four courses with exam results at 70% or higher will qualify for title of National Garden Clubs (NGC) "Landscape Design Consultant."

The exam and the course evaluation will be available online. The link to the exam and the evaluation will be emailed to participants on September 25, 2025. The test and evaluation will be available from noon on September 26 until 11:00 pm on October 4, 2025. Participants will have 3 hours to complete the test in one session. Do not log out or turn off the computer during the test.

There will be 30 multiple questions on material covered in the classroom. The exam may be completed using your class material and notes. The Site Plan Visit and Evaluations that participants complete during class is worth 40 points toward the final score.

Nonmembers may complete the courses and the exam, join an MGC garden club within a year from the last course, and become an NGC "Landscape Design Consultant."

All MGC Landscape Design Consultants also automatically become a member of the MGC Michigan Consultants Council at no cost.

There is also an option of continuing education to renew an NGC "Landscape Design Consultant" title every five years.
